Made up of 20+ youth, ages 13-23, from all over the Greater Atlanta Area, SAYAB was established as a part of Stronghold to effect change in the lives of women and children who have been victims of domestic violence and abuse!

SAYAB identifies the needs and special concerns of those who have been victims, come up with solutions to the problems identified. They develop partnerships and support to enact change and put their plans into action! SAYAB hosts events like the Strong Sounds Annual Benefit Concert, V-Day, California Pizza Kitchen and Chick-fil-A Nights, Dating Violence Awareness programs and much more. SAYAB meets once a month for a meeting and once a month for an event.
